**Chapter 102 Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan Review**  
**Fee Schedule (round all acreage to nearest 1/10th acre)**

**Small General Projects** (less than 1 acre disturbance)

Fee = \$75.00 (such as culvert installation, and minor re-grading)

**Linear Projects** (highway, pipeline)

Fee = \$400.00/linear mile

(Prorated and rounded off to the nearest 1/10 mile)

**Single Family Residential Development**

\$150.00/lot for 1 to 25 lots

(For more than 25 lots add \$75.00 for each additional lot)

**Other Land Development** (including apartments, townhouses, and trailer parks and agricultural, industrial, commercial)

\$250.00/disturbed acre (rounded to the nearest whole acre)

**EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL PLAN REVIEW**  
**FOR TIMBER HARVESTING FEE SCHEDULE\***

\$2.00 per project acre **OR** \$20.00 per earth disturbance acreage, whichever is greater

\* Note: Timber harvesting operations that will disturb 25 or more acres require a permit from DEP (the earth disturbance area is the total area of haul roads, landings, and skid trails). Inquiries as to whether or not a permit is required should be addressed to the Perry County Conservation District or DEP South Central Regional Office.

## **NPDES permits**

A NPDES permit for stormwater discharge from construction activities is required for all earthmoving construction activities over 5 acres of disturbance over the lifetime of the project.

A permit is also required for activities with 1 to 5 acres of disturbance where a point source discharge will impact waters of the Commonwealth.

If a project to be permitted is located in an Exceptional Value (EV) or High Quality (HQ) watershed an individual Permit is required, otherwise a General Permit is required. To apply for permit coverage an NOI (Notice of Intent) and accompanying documentation should be submitted with the Erosion Control Plan. The NOI can be found at [www.depweb.state.pa.us](http://www.depweb.state.pa.us) under "keyword" STORMWATER along with instructions, completeness checklists, technical program manuals and State training events for the regulated community.
