

### **Recycled Art Challenge Overview:**

- 1) **No Entry Fee required.** Students in grades K-12 are eligible to participate.
- 2) Artwork/Installations must be completed by **August 10, 2018**. Artwork/Installations must be brought to the Perry County Fairgrounds **no later** than 6 p.m. on Monday, **August 13** for set-up. Sites will be determined upon arrival.
- 3) Artwork/Installations must be able to **remain outdoors** during fair week.
- 4) Artwork/Installations will remain the sole property of their creators and must be picked up **no later** than Sunday afternoon on **August 19, 2018** from the fairgrounds.
- 5) Artwork/Installations must be free standing. (If not, the creators must provide their own equipment such as a table, panel, or any other means to display their work.)
- 6) The Conservation District and the Perry County Fair will not be held liable for damaged or stolen Artwork/Installations, although we hope this doesn't happen in the first place!
- 7) Artwork/Installations must be 'tasteful' in nature. Any artwork containing profanity, violence, or sexual content **will not be accepted**.
- 8) Student teams who participate in the Recycled Art Challenge will be asked to be photographed with their Artwork/Installation before or during fair week. These photos may be used for publication. Parents/guardians and students will be asked to sign a photo release form.
- 9) Artwork/Installations may be of any size, as long as they are not a safety hazard to the public.
- 10) Artwork/Installations **must be** constructed from post-consumer, repurposed, and/or recycling materials like plastics, metal, paper, glass, etc. (New materials such as paint and adhesive can be used.)
- 11) Student teams will be asked to write a brief description, containing the artists names, to accompany their Artwork/Installation that can be viewed by the public during fair week.
- 12) Each student team will be awarded with a certificate of participation. One lucky Artwork/Installation piece will be selected by a member of the Conservation District and will receive a special prize!
