**Aluminum foil, food & beverage containers**

**Glass food & beverage containers in: Clear, Brown and Green**

**Natural and pigmented plastic narrow-neck containers with symbols #1 PET and #2, #7 HDPE**

**Ferrous (Iron, Steel & Tin) cans**

**Newsprint – black and white or pigmented**

**Construction Paper, Craft Paper, Cereal Boxes, Shoe Boxes or similar items**

**Printer, Computer & Copy Paper**

**Junk Mail, Magazines, Catalogs & Phone Books**

**Corrugated Cardboard**

**Various Metal Household Items**

**Duncannon Borough/ Penn Township:** (717-834-4311/717-834-5281) The Duncannon Borough and Penn Twp. recycling center is open the second Saturday of each month. The drop off center is located at the end of Watershed Drive along Sherman's Creek. The times of operation are from 8 AM to 11 AM. No drop offs are permitted at any other time.

The curb side pickup will continue for the residents of Duncannon. Please have your materials out on the curb in a visible location by 8 AM. If not out by 8 AM or if the materials are in violation of the rules, they are subject to be left on the curb. Please clean your recyclables for the safety of the volunteers and success of the program.

All items must be cleaned and caps removed or are subject to rejection by the volunteers. Please place your items in plastic bags which are also recycled. Labels do not need removed.

Sorted materials:

**Aluminum soda cans** – please keep in a separate plastic bag.

**Newspapers** – please keep separated in brown paper bag or tied.

**Corrugated cardboard** – please keep separate in manageable tied bundles.

All other materials can be placed in the same bag to include:

**Aluminum cat food cans, foil and pie/baking pans**

**Clear, green and brown glass bottles.**

**Plastics with recycling symbols 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7**

**Ferrous (iron, steel, tin) cans**

**Construction paper, craft paper, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, or similar**

**Printer paper, computer paper, copy paper**

**Junk mail, magazines, catalogs, ad papers and phone books**
