Items Accepted at the Perry County Collection Centers As of June 1, 2009

Aluminum Cans

Rinsed and crushed. Foil is also accepted.

Bi- Metal (tin) Cans

Rinsed and crushed.

Office Grade Paper

Sheets or shredded. Will collect loose. Please use an easily emptied container or bag.

Magazines

Newspapers

All Types of Books

Tied securely. May also be put in paper bags. No staples! No plastic bags!

Cardboard

Flattened cardboard, cereal and shipping boxes.

No packing material.

Plastic Containers & Bottles

Rinsed, *no caps or lids*, and CRUSHED, if possible.

Separated in groups as follows:

- #1 PETE All #1 containers including soda and small water bottles
- #2 HDPE #2 natural, For example: "clear" milk and gallon water bottles
- #2 HDPE #2 colored such as detergent bottles and white or yellow milk jugs

All Perry County Recycling Centers are manned by volunteers. Having your recyclables separated and rinsed with the lids removed, makes their job more pleasant.

Please do NOT have trash in with your recyclables. Violators will be prosecuted!
